EAST AFRICA'S MINING AND ENERGY INDUSTRY ON SPOTLIGHT AT EAMEC 2019

As commodity prices rise, the East African region presents a relatively under explored mining jurisdiction with vast potential. Regional infrastructure development, especially key transport links between East African countries, also strengthen the position of the region to become a strategic hub due to its proximity to the Middle Eastern markets.

On the Energy side, with the latest onshore Oil discoveries in Kenya and Uganda and offshore gas discoveries in Tanzania and Mozambique, the region has attracted significant foreign investment in developing the necessary infrastructure. At the same time, East Africa has made significant progress in increasing access to electricity to all its people, fueled by an investment surge in renewable energy projects.

The First Eastern Africa Mining and Energy Conference and Exhibition will take place 15 – 17 October 2019 at the Kenyatta International Convention Centre in Nairobi, Kenya. EAMEC will be the first regional event to gather the region's government officials with representatives of the mining and energy value chains to discuss challenges on skills mismatch, opportunities on infrastructure investment, and other key issues that will ensure the sustainable development of these industries in the Region.
